EMIS 2.0 has many features to help ensure you receive the information you need in the most efficient manner possible.

ADVANCED SEARCH (with Boolean capabilities)

Advanced search provides the tools to simultaneously search historical content while filtering newly published content on a single field or combination of fields.

- You can search and filter Platts textual content (pages or reports) by keyword(s), page number(s), Platts **Service ID**(s) and/or a variety of Platts **topic code**(s), e.g. region, market and general topic code... while limiting your search by a date range
- You can also apply Boolean search logic to further narrow your search.

QUICK SEARCH

Quick search is a fast and efficient option to access Platts textual content from anywhere within the application.

- Enter the desired page number and select the Platts Service ID. Then click "Go" to get a filtered news window based on these criteria.



FILTER BY MARKET OR SERVICE ID

Within the News & Pages or Reports tabs you can access pre-filtered views by market by clicking on one of the markets listed (Oil, Electric Power, Natural Gas, Petrochemicals, Metals or Risk) in the second horizontal navigation bar, or by specific Platts Service ID by selecting a Platts service from the "Select Service ID" drop-down list. The list of Service IDs changes dynamically to match the position on the second horizontal navigation bar, e.g. selecting Oil from within the News & Pages section will list only Service IDs related to oil.

MY VIEW TAB

Within the **My View** tab you can create and manage personalized custom layouts and content alerts.

My Layout allows you to create and manage one or more custom filtered content modules and then arrange the modules to your preference. You can also quickly set an alert from one of the custom layouts by clicking on the icon associated with the desired headline.

Within **My Alert** you can create and manage automated delivery of specific content once it's published by Platts.

You can:

- Choose the specific content: Service ID and page #.
- Choose the delivery mechanism: email or FTP
- Group alerts together for easier management
- Manage saved alerts: edit or delete
- Suspend/Reactivate, edit or delete alerts
- View recent history of triggered alerts

PRICE DATA TAB

Within the **Price Data** tab you can search and retrieve historical Platts price data in multiple ways: Search by Symbol or keyword or by using the Symbol Search Tree.

Search by Symbol or Keyword. Search by Symbol provides a facility to search for available instruments using multiple criteria; enter desired symbol or search Platts descriptions using keywords.

MY ACCOUNT TAB

The **My Account** tab lets you check and edit information related to your EMIS 2.0 account.

View your profile in the **My Settings** box within the **Account Overview** page where you can:

- View your username
- Manage your password
- Verify the email address that is linked to your EMIS 2.0 account
- Get an up-to-date look at what Platts services you are subscribed to
- View a summary of your current month-to-date and historical (additional 2 months back) pay-per-view charges

The **Charge Details** tab lets you view the details of each pay-per-view transaction for any of these three periods.

Charge details include:

- Date and time of transaction
- Identification of content, i.e. a symbol or page or report ID
- The transaction amount
- Mode of access, browser or email alert
